

DCHE Bible Quizzing FAQs

What is Bible Quizzing? Simply stated, it is a tool that will motivate young people to learn God's word, work together, and expand their horizons. Quizzers practice weekly, and compete against other teams quarterly, as they enjoy fellowship, fun, and Christ-centered competition.

How does a quiz work? As questions are read, teams jump up from quiz seats which electronically determine the quizzers who are up first. The winner of the jump can score points by correctly answering the question from that year's material. Teamwork, knowledge, strategy, and physical skill are all attributes of a good quiz team.

Who can be involved? Young people ages 6 – 18. Bible Quizzing is inter-denominational. Since questions are not interpretive and come directly from the Scripture text (Berean Study Bible), quizzers from different denominations can quiz and fellowship together.

What will we be studying? This season, students across the country are learning the books of Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians and Colossians. No prior knowledge is necessary.

When and where do you meet? We meet on Wednesdays, 12:30pm – 1:25pm at Stone Mountain First UMC 5312 W Mountain St., Stone Mountain, GA 30083

What is the cost? The cost is \$25 for an Annual Membership. It includes a pocket-sized study Bible, T-Shirt, team competition fees and access to printable activity worksheets and questions.

Do all the quizzers have to attend the quarterly competitions? No. Although, we encourage quizzers to attend so that they can interact with a lot of other quizzers who are serious about studying the Word of God, attendance is not a requirement.

Do we have to pay for our own travel costs to the quarterly competitions? Yes. Each family is responsible for transporting their child(ren) to the quarterly competitions and to arrange their own lodging. Some families have carpooled in the past.

How do we get started? Enroll on the DCHE website, pay the \$25 annual membership fee and come to the Wednesday meetings.

Do we have to start from the beginning or can we start later and not be behind everyone else? Fortunately, with Bible Quizzing, a quizzers can start at the beginning of each new quarter and he or she will be at the same place as everyone else.
